



EFI2023 Submission Instructions

The authors are invited to submit an abstract before or on **December 7th, 2022**.

Requirements

When submitting your abstract please follow the Abstract submission guidelines.

- All papers must be original and not simultaneously submitted to another journal or conference;
- The abstract must be written in **scientific English**;
- Have a maximum length of **2000 characters (including spaces)**;
- A **short informative title** containing the major keywords (**150-200 characters including spaces**). The title should not contain abbreviations;
- Please minimize the use of abbreviations, and do not cite references in the abstract;
- The author's institutional affiliations;
- All accepted abstracts will be published in the **HLA journal volume 101:4**, and available online on **March 15, 2023**. By submitting your abstract you consent to give EFI permission to publish it.

1. MHC Evolution, Population Genetics
2. New technologies in Immunogenetics
3. NK cells & KIR
4. Immunogenetics in Organ Transplantation
5. Bioinformatics, data analysis in Immunogenetics
6. Immunotherapy, Gene Therapy, Cellular Therapy
7. Hematopoietic stem-cell transplantation (HSCT)
8. Autoimmunity, Infection, Reproduction & Cancer

All the abstracts will be peer-reviewed by the **EFI Scientific committee**. The authors will receive notification of the decision. Authors selected for presentation (oral communication or poster) will be required to register for the conference
